Grace to you and peace from God our Father and our Lord and Savior Jesus the Christ.

The birth of Jesus Christ is so significant that you and I are here to worship Him, and those at home watching on-line are doing so to worship Jesus. God created us and He knows our limitations. God knows we need rest. Our bodies yearn for that Sabbath rest. It is ingrained in us since the beginning of time. It is in our DNA. Our human bodies were not built to go full bore seven days a week. It is like burning the candle at both ends and it burns out completely before too long. We were put on this earth to know Jesus, to be in relationship with Jesus. Worshipping Jesus with God's people, with family and friends, is one of the absolute greatest activities God has given to us. Your soul, my soul yearns to worship Jesus and it does so because it is only Jesus who can bring great satisfaction to your soul, to your life.

Jesus began his ministry at the age of 30 or thereabouts. The Bible tells us that Jesus was tempted by Satan in all ways, yet he never sinned. Matthew 4:8-10 (NLT2) 8 Next the devil took him to the peak of a very high mountain and showed him the kingdoms of the world and all their glory. 9 "I will give it all to you [you can have it all]," Satan said, "if you will kneel down and worship me." 10 "Get out of here, Satan," Jesus told him. "For the Scriptures say, 'You must worship the LORD your God and serve only him."" If you have never prayed that prayer, please do so this evening while you still have the time and opportunity to do so. The Bible says, "Today is the day of salvation." And that is something none of us want to miss out on for Jesus came to save you. Please let Him do it now.
